USEFUL TECHNIQUES:

- add appoggiaturas (combinations of above and below, chromatic and diatonic); where there already exist appoggiaturas, use alternative ones
- add scalar connections (which may include appoggiaturas)
- use chordal skips
- employ turns, repeated notes and other re-articulations
- introduce rhythmic delay or anticipation; light syncopation
- embellish the cadences; full cadences more than half cadences
- melismatically connect large-scale phrases (e.g., antecedent and consequent)
